## **Mayor Announces Personal Property Declaration Deadline Extend to November 15<sup>th</sup>**

TORRINGTON CT –November 3, 2011– Mayor Bingham is happy to announce that Governor Malloy has issued an Executive Order that will extend the filing deadline for personal property declarations to November 15<sup>th</sup> from November 1<sup>st</sup>. Any business that files does not need a written extension to receive this wavier. However, any business that submits their declaration after November 15<sup>th</sup> will be subject to the standard penalty under Connecticut state law unless they have a written waiver granted by the City Assessor.

“I am very happy that the Governor made this decision. Our local businesses have already endured enough of a burden due to this winter storm and to face a potential tax liability on top of that would have been wrong. Here in Torrington we have been doing everything we can to lighten the load that our residents and businesses have to carry because of Storm Alfred,” said Mayor Bingham.
