Thursday, January 26, 2012 Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Tim Driscoll at 5:45

The meeting was called to address the matter of a complaint dated December 29, 2011 brought by Mary Bagnashi against Mayor Ryan Bingham, City Corporation Counsel Ernestine Weaver, the Torrington City Council, the Charter Revision Commission, Personnel Director Thomas Gritt, the Torrington Housing Authority Commissioners, and Chairman of the Torrington Housing Authority, Attorney Samuel Slaiby

It was determined that the complaint against the Torrington Housing Authority Commission and Chairman Samuel Slaiby would not be considered as the Board of Ethics has no authority over either.

After a preliminary investigation by the Board of Ethics, it has been determined that a probable cause hearing will not be held.

Tim Driscoll stepped down as Chairman. John Todor was nominated by Kate Rines to be Chairman. The nomination was seconded by Candace Barth. Vote was unanimous to make John Todor Chairman.

Kate Rines was made a full member upon resignation of Donna Mattiello.

There was discussion about forms for complaints to the Board being filled out in the office of Corporation Counsel rather than the City Clerk's Office. John Todor will speak with Corporation Counsel about the change.

John Todor moved to adjourn, Kate Rines seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 6:20.
