### **HERE ARE THE CHANGES TO THE BID OPENING:**

- 1) **THE BID OPENING HAS BEEN CHANGED TO APRIL 23, 2009 AT 10:00 AM**
- 2) **There will be a MANDATORY walk-thru on Tuesday, April 14, 2009 at 10:00 AM at the Torrington Police Department, 576 Main Street, Torrington.**
- 3) **The monitor requested should be a LCD Digital Signage so that it will be capable to run 24/7. The warranty on these monitors should be three (3) years.**

### **HERE ARE THE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS SUBMITTED BY VENDORS:**

- 1) **Can we get some info regarding the system functionality? Will this be a 2'x2' video wall, digital signage or are the 4 displays in different locations? The monitors will be set-up in four (4) separate displays.**
- 2) **As for the sources, are they all the same or will there be different sources like computer, cable, TV, DVD, etc.? There will be two (2) sources for these monitors which are a computer and Close Circuit TV.**
- 3) **Will Torrington provide the electrical requirements? The electrical boxes that are in place shall be sufficient but the contractor will have to put drop down wiring to install the monitors.**
- 4) **Will the A/V contractor be responsible for pulling cable & providing a cable path? The contractor who is awarded the bid shall be responsible for the installation and the cable connections.**
- 5) **Do you require a process for proposing a product substitution? If the product is different from the bid specifications, the contractor must provide the brand and the specifications for the brand to be supplied. The smallest size monitor allowed will be a 40" inch and the largest size monitor allowed will be a 42" inch.**
- 6) **What will the screen viewing configurations be? One source on one screen, one source on two screens, etc.? The source will be that three (3) monitors will be used for close circuit TV and one (1) will be used for**

**the computer.**

- 7) Will program audio (sound) support be required for the monitoring area? **Sound is not required for the monitoring area.**
- 8) Will there just be a straight wall mount system required or articulating arm and swivel? **The required system will be a straight wall mount system.**
- 9) What equipment must be taken down and removed to complete the installation? **All existing monitors will be removed and discarded per bid specifications.**
- 10) Is there an existing system in place? Will it need uninstallation? **There is an existing system in place but will not require uninstallation.**
- 11) Are there drawings or flows for the existing system? **There are no drawings for the layout that is in place and that is why they are requesting a mandatory walk thru for all potential bidders.**
- 12) What is the wall type the displays will be mounted to? **The existing wall type is sheet rock with 2x4 wood studs behind the sheet rock.**
