

INVITATION TO BID

“PAVEMENT REHABILITATION OF LITCHFIELD ST.,
WINTHROP ST., WATER ST., & CHURCH ST.”

Sealed bids are invited and will be received by the City of Torrington, at the office of the City Purchasing Agent, “Temporary” City Hall, 59 Field Street, Torrington, Connecticut until 10:00 A.M., **April 5, 2010** at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. In the event of the closure of City Hall, the bid will be opened on the following business day that City Hall is opened.

The work is comprised of furnishing all equipment, labor, material, plant, and superintendence to perform all work necessary for pavement rehabilitation including milling sections of existing road surfaces, providing a full depth reconstruction of pavement for one section of road, paving, providing storm drainage improvements including replacing catch basins and tops, adjustment and repair of sanitary sewer manhole frame and covers, providing utility company coordination regarding adjustment of utility valve tops, etc., traffic control, and associated miscellaneous work for the City of Torrington.

Each bid must be submitted on the forms provided and in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside, the name of the bidder, his address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted, bid number and bid opening date/time clearly identified on the outside of the envelope/package.

A bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid shall accompany each bid. A non-collusion statement for Prime Contractors and any addendum acknowledgement must also be submitted at the time of the bid.

A performance, labor and materials bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted bid will be required.

This is a State of Connecticut and Federal assisted contract. The contractor must comply with the requirements as specified herein. The bidder agrees that no less than five percent (5%) of the awarded contract value shall be performed by a Connecticut Department of Transportation approved DBE firm. The successful bidder must indicate the disadvantaged business enterprise(s) it intends to utilize to achieve the above stated percentage prior to award of contract. The contractors bidding on this project shall have an approved Affirmative Action Plan with the Connecticut Department of Transportation.

Attention of bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of Davis-Bacon wages, and compliance with certain local, state and federal requirements. This is a federally funded project under ARRA. Contractors should be aware of special job creation retention and “Buy American” compliance and reporting requirements and other related conditions specific to the ARRA Act of 2009 provisions.

The Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Specifications, and other Contract Documents may be obtained or examined at the Office of the City Purchasing Agent, “Temporary” City Hall, 59 Field Street, Torrington, Connecticut, M - W 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Th 9:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m., F 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit payable to the City of Torrington will be required of all prospective bidders.

Bids to receive consideration, must be in the hands of the authorized representative, no later than the day and hour mentioned above. Any bid received after the date and time specified will be rejected.

The City of Torrington reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities, or; to award the contract to a bidder other than the lowest bid, and to award the contract as it feels will best serve the public interest.

All bids will be considered valid for a period of sixty (60) days.
